Preview party Friday evening before show. **Guest Artist: Regina Scroggins/** gourds, baskets, and glass Regina was inspired by the cousin of Larry Lemons, a basket maker from Oklahoma, who demonstrated for CTAA in the past. After giving a brief synopsis of the history of basket weaving, Regina shared her expertise in learning this new art form. She took a Pine Needle basket weaving workshop recently & brought several examples of her work to our meeting. Many were in a "free form" style with several amazing varieties of stitch work in natural pine needles, various dye techniques, and interesting articles for the central beginnings of her weavings. One was the use of stones in which she uses Dremel tool with a diamond bit to drill holes in the stones for basket centers. Glycerin or water softens the pine needles to make them pliable. For dyes she uses Rit dye or even acrylic paint. Her threads include copper wiring, deer sinew, threads, and embroidery thread. The time invested in her art pieces varies according to the variety of stitches and intricate patterns involved. Prices range from \$ 125-\$325. Pieces must be for sale; there shall be a 20% commission paid to the Grahan Art Guild on all sales. Credit card fees for sales will also be deducted from your sale price. Sales tax will be collected and remitted by the art center.
