September 12: Sharon Brown will showcase her fused glass art



Guest Artist: Mattie Ferguson-horsewoman, photographer, graphic artist. Mattie is a senior student attending Texas A & M University at Stephenville, Texas graduating in December, '25. She will graduate with a degree in Equine Marketing combined with an emphasis in photography & graphic design. Mattie's early

years-to-present include a background in family ranching, cowboys, horses, & rodeo. (She is a barrel racer & photographer). This history has provided her with the ability to gather source files as reference material for the contemporary western genre she produces in her marketing business. Page 2 Mattie considers Art as the main aspect of the artistic process. As part of the "Young Guns" of Western art she incorporates AI as one of the tools in her business technology. The artist paints equine art with simple brilliantly colored backgrounds. She also brings graphic line work with "neon signs" together for a new look in her marketing skills. Another new feature in her photography is the use of a "mirrorless" camera that allows more light, especially helpful with night vision photographs. As artists, it provides another means of capturing subject matter under low light conditions, such as at sunset or nighttime. Her other techniques include the mediums of pen-andink, watercolor, and acrylics. One of her marketing strategies is the use of Equine Videography. 


