- E. The "Artist of the Month" was voted on and by a majority vote, Barbara Yerby was named.

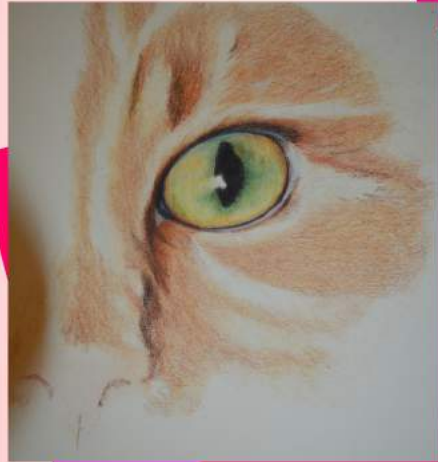
Meeting Adjourned:

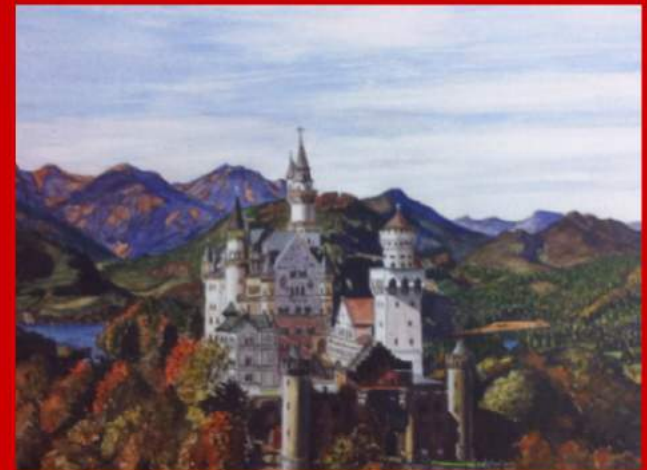
