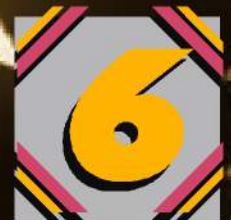

# JENNIFER'S GELLI PLATE PRINTS



I have been playing with the gelli prints. Kathy Hunter, an artist from Wichita, Kansas; was kind enough to invite me out to her cabin here in Creede to experiment with the process. Since our October presenter is doing her program on Gelli printing I thought I would give an example of what I have learned. After searching online for information, I learned that you can make your own gelli plate from unflavored gelatin and glycerin. So I made one! It's shown at the bottom. I had on hand, my tubes of watercolors so I tried those out with a small pastry roller as my brayer. Although I am going to melt my plate down (do not do that with a "bought" plate) and pour it into a smaller pan to reset, I was pleased with the results shown in the other two photos. I think everyone will enjoy learning this printing process!
